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

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ABSTRACT

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Polysemy, the phenomenon whereby a linguistic unit exhibits multiple distinct yet related meaning. Polysemy is very important for students, especially the students like songs. By knowing it, readers will more easily understand the meaning of the lyrics of the song, with the lyrics can express someone's feelings or thoughts.

The purpose of this research is to know the types of polysemy and to describe the meaning of the polysemy of Maher Zain's selected song. In this study, the researcher reported all song lyrics as data.

This research used library research. The data source is all the lyrics of the songs Thank You Allah . The data analysis used the following steps: prepare the data for analysis, read all the data, begin detailed analysis with a coding proses, use the coding process to generate a description of the setting, a final step in data analysis involves making an interpretation from the data, and conclusion.

The results obtained in this study are described based on the type of polysemy which consists of three parts, namely (1) polysemy verb which consists of six data. (2) A polysemy noun consists of three data, and (3) polysemy adjectives consists of five data. The total amount of song lyric data that has been analyzed and contains polysemic meaning is fourteen data. So in this research, it can be concluded that lyrics of the song used many polysemy verbs.

ABSTRAK

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Judul : Analisis Makna dalam Lirik Lagu Terpilih dari Maher Zain

Polisemi, fenomena dimana suatu unit linguistic menunjukkan banyak makna yang berbeda namun saling berhubungan. Polisemi sangat penting bagi siswa, terutama siswa yang menyukai lagu. Dengan mengetahuinya, mereka akan lebih mudah memahami makna dari lirik lagu tersebut, dengan lirik tersebut dapat mengungkapkan perasaan atau pikiran seseorang.

Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis polisemi dan mendeskripsikan maknanya polisemi lagu pilihan Maher Zain. Dalam penelitian ini, peneliti melaporkan semua lirik lagu sebagai data.

Penelitian ini menggunakan penelitian kepustakaan. Sumber data adalah semua lirik lagu Terima Kasih Allah. Analisis data menggunakan langkah-langkah berikut: menyiapkan data untuk analisis, membaca semua data, memulai analisis rinci dengan proses pengkodean, menggunakan proses pengkodean untuk menghasilkan deskripsi pengaturan, langkah terakhir dalam analisis data melibatkan membuat interpretasi dari data, dan kesimpulan.

Hasil yang diperoleh dalam penelitian ini dideskripsikan berdasarkan jenis polisemi yang terdiri dari tiga bagian, yaitu (1) verba polisemi yang terdiri dari enam data. (2) Kata benda polisemi terdiri dari tiga data, dan (3) kata sifat polisemi terdiri dari lima data. Jumlah total data lirik lagu yang telah dianalisis dan mengandung makna polisemik adalah 26 data. Sehingga dalam penelitian ini dapat disimpulkan bahwa lirik lagu banyak menggunakan verba polisemi.

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CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the problem

Language is a tool of communication. A language has a systematic order to communicate by using sounds and conventional symbols. Language is so important in life. Everything in this world needs language. By a language human can interact with other people. Every human uses language to convey their knowledge, opinion, ideas, feelings and emotions. People cannot communicate and interact to other people without language.

Knowledge of English is very important for students, students can get to know how to frame sentences, how to use words in dialogues while speaking to others. As every word has a particular context where it fits right, using words in such a manner in English is an art that can only be mastered by practice. When the students really have positive attitude towards the target language (English), they will enjoy learning English as much as possible and thinking English as an important part of learning and will put great effort to learn.¹ Therefore, they will improve their language skill also.

Which case, English is the first foreign language in Indonesia that one of many languages in the world. English is one has been used as international language. It is used as a medium of communication in forum international meeting. One region has different language with other. It means that many people in this world use English are tool to develop the relations between nations. That makes English is very important for people. So, as an international social someone can use English to develop his or her relation to foreign people.

In the classroom, the lecturers and students are the language learners. The lecturers learn from what they teach to students and the students learn from what they get from the lecturers.³ When one of those two learners does not interact well with each other's, communication will fail.

Polysemy is the capacity for a word or phrase to have multiple related meanings. The term semantic was used broadly to refer to the study of meaning.⁴ Semantic is concerned with the resources (vocabulary and a system for calculating phrase, clause, and sentence-meanings) provide by a language,

and pragmatics is concerned with how those resource are put to use in communication.

Lexical meaning is a term that is equivalent to term ‘word meaning’, and it has another technical term, ‘lexeme’ is dictionary-words. The noun ‘lexeme’ is related to the words ‘lexical’ and ‘lexicon’ that has the same meaning as ‘vocabulary’ and ‘dictionary’.⁵ The term lexical meaning interpreted as the meaning of lexemes depends upon the meaning of the sentence in which they occur.

Polysemy is one of the quite complex relations of meaning in the process of translation. Because a translator is difficult to translate the meaning of a word correctly without seeing the context of the sentence as a whole. Polysemy is commonly interpreted as a unit of language (especially words can also be phrases) that have more than one meaning.⁶

There are several reasons why the researcher interested in discussing the polysemy in the choice of Maher Zain Songs. First, there are many da’wah messages in his song. This reason supported by Mutia Rahma Wati and friends, in their Journal Article, they conclude that Maher Zain’s song as well have a lot of the messages and beautiful lyrics.⁷ Second, very well known in

various and know about Islam better through song. This reason supported by Qurrotul'Ain, in her thesis, she states that interest especially all about Islam, and interest to learn about Islam more deeply because as far as we know that Maher Zain is an Islamic singer with Islamic song.⁸

Based on the previous studies that have been explained, this thesis focuses on analyzed polysemy in albums *Thank You Allah* and *Forgive Me* by Maher Zain. This research focused on the type of polysemy and form of polysemy. The researcher chose polysemy because the researcher wants to know how many polysemies are contained in the Maher Zain songs especially in types of polysemy and forms of polysemy. Besides, no one has ever studied the polysemy contained in the lyrics of the song, and some researchers conducted polysemy research on the local language.

Here the researcher examined the polysemy in Maher Zain's song. "In the process, he ended up finding celebrity status anyway. His debut album, *Thank You Allah*, released in late 2009, became a worldwide sensation: the record took top position on Amazon.com's world music chart and was the best-selling album of the decade in Malaysia. In Indonesia, it even knocked Justin Bieber" off the leading spot. In this case, the researcher used two albums from Maher Zain as data to be analyzed.

The song lyric is a person's expression about something that has been seen, heard or experienced. The lyrics are included in the genre of literature because the lyrics are literary works (poems) that contain the outpourings of personal feelings, the composition of a song. Each song has a specific purpose to convey the author to the public as a listener. The song contains a sequence of words that are strung together nicely with the style of the language appealed by the creator and performer with a beautiful voice singing. The purpose of this research is, the researcher hope from this research, the person who read this paper can more understand about polysemy especially in types of polysemy and forms of polysemy.

B. Focus on the Problem

In this research the writer focused on the type of polysemy; there are polysemy verbs, nouns, adverb, adjectives, and focused on the type of polysemy in the lyrics 'Maher Zain' song. This research, the writer only focuses on polysemy. Three types of polysemy analyzed by the writer; there are polysemy verbs, polysemy adjectives, and polysemy nouns. In this research the writer would explain and research about type of polysemy and meaning of polysemy.

C. Formulation of the Study

From the background of the study, the researcher would like to write the problem of study:

1. What are the types of polysemy in selected song's lyrics by Maher Zain?
2. What are the meanings of polysemy in selected song's lyrics by Maher Zain?

D. Objective of the Research

Based on formulation of the problems, the objectives of this study are to find:

1. To analyze the types of polysemy found in selected song's lyric by Maher Zain.
2. To describe the meaning of polysemy used in selected song by Maher Zain.

E. Significances of the Study

This research is expected to be useful for researchers, readers, and other interested parties, especially for those who cultivate language studies. In the process, the results of this study can also be used as a further foothold for documenting forms of polysemy in the lyrics of Maher Zain songs. This research contributes as the reference from the study of semantics, and the writer hopes from this research, the person who read this paper can more understand about semantic especially about lexical meaning in polysemy, and

the reader can know what are polysemy verbs, adjectives, and nouns in the lyrics of 'Maher Zain' song. Also the reader can better understand related to the type of polysemy and form of polysemy. This study can help song listeners to know better and understand that in the song lyrics, when examined, several words have more than one meaning; it's called polysemy.

F. Definition of Key Terms

1. Polysemy

Polysemy is characterized as the phenomenon whereby a single word form is associated with two or several related sense. It is distinguished from monosemy single meaning and homonymy two or several unrelated meanings. The study of relationships between words and how construct the meaning, sheds light on how to experience the word and how to understand others. Some types of semantics are distinguished by level or part of the language that is the object of his investigation⁹

2. Types of Polysemy

Types of polysemy are polysemy verb. Polysemy verb, polysemy noun, polysemy adjective, polysemy adverb divided into a single adverb and a combined adverb.

3. Maher Zain Song

Maher Zain is a singer and song writer. Maher Zain became a popular singer, because his good voice, language features in his song. He used Arabic and English in his song. Arabic is kind of popular language in Islamic state, but English is international language. So, Arabic and English are used in his song that is more available for knowing by a lot of people in the world.

G. Review of Relate Findings

Several previous research. The first previous research was carried out by Tahir. The results of this previous research, the researcher found the words polysemy in Adele song. Based on the analysis of the data there are twenty polysemy that found in fifteen songs of Adele and seven words classes, namely: verb: find, close, down, hold, play, end, hurt, like, see, tell, made, save; noun: back, out, down, one, end, hurt; adjective: good, hard; adverb: back, close, out, over; conjunction: over, like; preposition: on; and numeral: one. In this research, the researcher also found the words that has polysemy meaning and categorize them in the type of polysemy and form of polysemy. The data used by researcher is same as previous research used song lyrics.¹⁰

The second previous research carried out by Setianingrum. This previous research found about type of polysemy and the data used was vocabulary in the handbook of Islamic banking. Based on the previous

research, this research found some of the same research results. In this research also found type of polysemy, and the the researcher categorize in three types the are polysemy verb, polysemy noun, and polysemy adjective. This research used different data with the previous research. The previous research used vocabulary in the handbook of Islamic banking and in this research used song lyrics by Maher Zain.¹¹

The third previous research carried by Retnomurti. This previous research found words polysemy in novels *Waiting on you* and *the Dancer*. Based on the data there are five words polysemy namely: distance, recognize, hold, body and study.¹²

The fourth previous research by Ahyaroni. The results of this previous research, the researcher found the words polysemy in Maher zain song. Based on this research found some of the same research results. In this research also found type of polysemy which consists of three parts, namely polysemy verb which consists of twelve data. The form of polysemy found is eight data action verbs, three data state verbs, and one data process verb. A polysemy noun consists of six data. The form of polysemy found is six data basic nouns, and polysemy adjectives consist of eight data. The form of polysemy found is eight data basic adjectives. The total amount of song lyric data that has been

analyzed and contains polysemic meaning is twenty six data. So in this research, it can be concluded that lyrics of the song used many polysemy verbs in the form of action verbs.¹³

Based on the fifth previous research above, the researcher will analyzed the selected song lyrics by Maher Zain, in the songs album there are any types of polysemy that the author's song uses in every statement Every song has different meaning.

H. Research Method

1. Kind and Time of Research

This research use library research to extend theory and references to sustain the analysis. The collected data are analyzed in accordance with theories chosen, and describe based on the polysemy. This research has been started in September 2021 to December 2021

2. Instrument of the research

The instruments in this research are several documents. The following indicators, table is used to analyzed data and makes coding. In appendix 2 there will be data result.

a. Document

The document is as song by Maher Zain from 2 albums Thank You Allah and Forgive Me.

3. Technique of Data Collection

In this research, the researcher use the documents are selected song lyrics. The lyrics are the main of data of the research. In collecting the data, the research brow seeds the lyrics of selected song from Maher Zain.

In getting the data, the researcher uses the documentation method to get the detail data found in the song lyric from Maher Zain.

The techniques used in collecting data are:

- a. Reading, the writer reads song lyric by Maher Zain from <https://www.azlyrics.com/m/maherzain.html>
- b. The data selected by the writer then collect systematically in accordance with the problems of the study.

4. Technique of Data Analysis

The data are analyzed to answer the research question. The researcher must determine whether the result answers the research

questions. The researcher used John W Creswell theory to analyze the data. The data were analyzed through the following procedure:¹⁴

- a. Prepare the data for analysis. The researcher prepared data from selected song lyrics from Maher Zain, they are the Always Be There, Thank You Allah, Baraka Allahu Lakuma, Rest of My Life, Hold My hand, I Love You So, Mawlaya, My Little Girl, Paradise, Masha Allah, In Syaa Allah.
- b. Read All the Data. Read all the data carefully, look for the same word in different contexts, searched for the type of polysemy based on the context. Put some notes about the polysemy in sentence.
- c. Begin detailed analysis with a coding process. The researcher begun to detail analysis, and then the researcher made a coding for Lines and polysemy. L for Lines, P. Adj for polysemy adjective, P. Adv for polysemy adverb, P. N for polysemy noun, P. V for polysemi verb.
- d. Use the coding process to generate a description of the setting. The researcher identified and interconnected the data to the storyline of the song, the researcher generated codes for the description

- e. A final step in data analysis involves making an interpretation from the data.
 - f. Making conclusion from all the discussion carried out related to the use of polysemy in the lyrics of the song Maher Zain.
5. Checking Data Trustworthiness

In this research the researcher used asking expert validity. The researcher gave the instrument to validator before researcher to research. The validator is the lecturer of Speaking at University Syekh Ali Hasan Ahmad Addary Padangsidempuan. The validator checked the instrument until the instrument had been valid.

CHAPTER II

LITERATURE REVIEW

A. Theoretical Description

1. Semantic

There are several types of semantic namely, homonymy (meaning disorder), synonymy (similarity of meaning), hyponymy (scope of the meaning), antonymy (opposite or contradictory meaning), and polysemy (diversity of meaning).¹⁵ The next explained related to the type of relationship of meaning about homonymy, synonymy, hyponymy, antonymy, while for polysemy would explain separately in detail in the following description.

a. Homonymy

Homonymy is divided into homophones and homographs.¹⁶ The first is based on the sound equation criteria, while the second is based on the spelling equation criteria. Words which homogeneity is based on sound and spelling similarity are called complete homonyms, whereas words which homogeneity only meets one criterion are called partial homonyms. Homonyms are two or more lexemes that have an identical sound, but the meaning is completely different. Example of the word 'stock' in the following sentences:

'He has a lot of stock in the warehouse'

'He sells stock and bounds'

'He feeds the stock on his form well'

Based on this example, this search effort is called homonym reinterpreted or homonym tracking.

b. Synonymy

A synonym is an expression or expression that is more or less the same meaning as another expression (Gudai, 1989, p.11).“A synonym is a semantic relationship that states the similarity of meaning between one unit of speech” with another unit of utterance. Two utterances that are synonymous meaning would not be the same. The inequality that occurs due to several factors namely, the first time factor, place or region factors and formality factors. It is said that synonymy has more or less the same meaning as other expressions but the additional "more or less" is deliberately used. It is important to note that the synonymy relation does not contain perfect similarity in meaning.

c. Hyponymy

Hyponymy is some words, phrases, or sentences, besides having synonyms and antonyms, it can also have some features or components of the same meaning so that, it has a reason to include it in one class.¹⁷ It can be concluded “hyponym is a semantic relationship between a form of utterance” whose meaning is included in another form of utterance.

2. Lexical Meaning

According to Lyons stated that the“noun lexeme is of course related to the words, lexical and lexicon (we can think of, lexicon as having the same meaning as vocabulary” or dictionary)”. The lexical

meaning (lexical meaning, semantic meaning, external meaning) is the meaning of the word stand-alone both in the basic form and in the complex form (derivative) and the existing meaning remains like what we can see in the dictionary.

As is stated p.12),¹⁸ it is just the lexical meaning which is "the most outstanding individual of the word that makes it different from any other word". "The lexical meaning of a word may be thought of as the specific value it has in a particular language system," and the 'personality' it acquires through usage within that system.

The lexical meaning can also mean the meaning which corresponds to its reference, the meaning which corresponds to the observations of the five senses, or the real-life meaning in our life. Therefore many people conclude that lexical meaning refers to the real meaning.

3. Definition of Polysemy

The meaning of a word is sometimes not singular, meaning a word may have many meanings. This word that has many meanings is called polysemy. Polysemy is the state or phenomenon in which the words that have more than one meaning. In other words, it can be described as multiple meanings of words. The words are considered to be related etymologically.¹⁹

Polysemy is a word that means more than one or doubles. Polysemy is a word that has a different set of meanings. The multiplicity of meaning in polysemy can be described logically by connecting the

meanings of the word to its primary meaning. This is because these meanings are associative with their primary meanings.²⁰ Polysemy is a double-meaning word with every meaning having a close connection of meaning.

Polysemy also is an interesting phenomenon that concerns case in which a word or phrase enjoys multiple related meaning.²¹ (polysemy is as the form ambiguity were two or more related senses are associated with that same word, consider the meaning of glass in *I emptied the glass* (container) and *I drank glass* (contents of the container).²²

Polysemy is commonly defined as the association of two or more related meanings with a single phonological The definition looks straightforward enough, and unlikely, of itself, to arouse controversy.²³

4. Kinds of polysemy

a. Polysemy of verb

Verbs are common words that populate predicate functions in sentence structure and mean deeds, actions, and circumstances. The example is:

- a) To succeed extensification program and tax intensification, apparatus of fiskus will actively **comb** the business center following shopping center and shops, including in Medan city.
- b) The beautiful woman **combs** her hair from the end of her hair.

From the above example, the meaning of combing is disciplining. From the second example, while the lexical meaning is smoothed out with a comb. So the sentences (a) and sentence (b) are called verbs polysemy.

Polysemy verb is a verb that describes a job or activity in both lexical and grammatical categories and can have more than one meaning.²⁴

b. Polysemy of Adjective

An adjective is a word that functions as a modifier of nouns. Adjectives are words that give more specific information to nouns or nouns in sentences. Polysemy adjective is a type of word adjective polysemy that describes an object, item, or object.²⁵ such as:

- a) The **bitter** experience of the promised past is no longer repeated.
- b) After drinking it turns out the coffee tasted **bitter**.

The bitter meaning in (a) is sad, disagreeable, while the lexical meaning in (b) is an odor that the sentences (a) and sentence (b) are called polysemes.

c. Polysemy of Noun

Semantically, nouns are lexical types or categories that contain material concepts or meanings that are both concrete and abstract. A noun is a word that usually occupies the function of subject or objects in

sentence structure and refers to living things (human, animal, plant), inanimate (goods), and concept.²⁶

- a) The king of the **kingdom** is holding a contest to find a wife.
- b) The **kingdom** of the jungle quickly hunts down his prey.

From this example, in sentence (a) the king means the leader or ruler of the region. While in sentence (b) the king means the ruler of the forest.

d. Polysemy of Adverb

In the phrase level, an adverb is a word that describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb. At the level of the clause, adverb limits or explains syntactic functions. Generally, the words or sentence parts describe by adverb function as a predicate. Informs of polysemy, polysemy adverb divided into a single adverb and a combined adverb. A single adverb consists of adverb base words, adverb affixed words and adverb re-words. A combined adverb consists of two adverbs in the form of basic words.²⁷

- a) The television would be **just** right for the living room
- b) She is a **just** woman

From this example, in sentence (a) the just means appropriate or fair, while in sentence (b) the just means able.

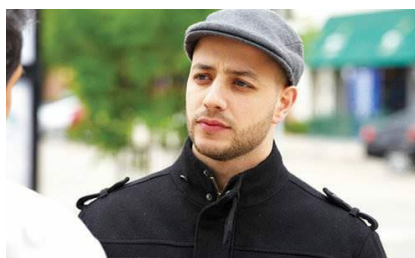

CHAPTER IV

The researcher has done the analysis and found the types of polysemy are polysemy noun, polysemy verb and polysemy adjective in the songs.

A. Types of Polysemy In Selected songs

Change in the meaning of a word that is still in one flow of meaning means including words that have a polemic, and each word can have a different meaning when used in different contexts. In this study, it has successfully identified the use of polysemy in the lyric of Maher Zain's song, namely the first album Thank You Allah and the second album Forgive Me. This research explained the type of polysemy in the lyric of the song. The result of the research explained as follows:

1. Polysemy verb

The polysemy of verb that shows the activities or action carried out by the offender or subject. Based on the result of this research, the researcher found in the form of the verb as follows:

The basic form of polysemy noun is a noun that does not get any affixes. Usually, it can be its own meaning without getting added. The result of basic noun polysemy data analysis explained with the following data:

Datum 1

“If you ask me about **love**, and what I know about it”

“As He promised He will always be there, to bless us with His **love** and His mercy”

Datum 2

“We’re here on this special day, our hearts are full of **pleasure**”

“Together worshipping Allah, seeking His **pleasure**”

“You brought joy to my soul, and **pleasure** to my eyes”

Datum 3

“And we just stopped feeling all the **pain** we cause, like it’s a daily basic affair”.

“Running in your veins, what about anger, love, and **pain**?”

“And all the **pain** I put you through, Mama, now I’m here for you”.

3. Polysemy Adjective

Based on the result of this research, the researcher found the form of polysemy adjective. An adjective is a word that gives a description of the state of an object or is constrained. Based on its shape, an adjective can be divided into two namely, basic adjective and derivative adjective. Each of the data would directly explain the type of polysemy and form of polysemy.

a. Polysemy adjective in the form of basic

The polysemy of basic adjectives is a polysemy adjective in the form of no affixes. The following data explained the data found related to the type of polysemy and also the form of polysemy:

Datum 1

“I’ll stay by your side honest and **true**, til the end of my time”

“Knowing that God is pleased with us too, it’s not a dream, this is so **true**.”

Datum 2

“And let’s pray for the **beautiful** world, the beautiful world I share with you”

“Tonight is the biggest happiness in your life, by Allah, you’re both **beautiful**!

Allah Allah”.

Datum 3

“God I can not express my gratitude!, but I’ll raise her **good**”.

“And now that we’re here feeling so **good**, about all the things that we went through”.

Datum 4

“The creator of you and me, the heavens and the **whole** universe”.

“The one that made us **whole** and free, the guardian of His true believers”.

Datum 5

“Every time you feel like you cannot go on, you feel so **lost** and that you’re so alone”

“I wanna thank you for all the things that you’ve done, you’ve done for me through all my years I’ve been **lost**” .

Based on the results of the research, it can be seen that there is a polysemy in the lyrics of Maher Zain’s song. The polysemy found was a type of polysemy. Types of polysemy include polysemy verbs, polysemy nouns, and polysemy adjectives.

B. Meaning of Polysemy

In this research there are fourteen datum the mean of polysemy which is analyzed from three types of polysemy, namely polysemy verb, polysemy noun and polysemy adjective. The datum as follow:

Datum 1**Type** : **Polysemy Verb**

Meaning : In this data, there is the same word which is the word “watching” which contains the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context of the sentence, the word “watching” has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means ‘supervise’ or monitor everything we do, while in the sentence (2) means ‘view’ which means to see and pay attention (usually the direction and distance are fixed).

Datum 2**Type** : **Polysemy Verb**

Meaning : The word „turn“ in the sentence above contains the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context the word „turn“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „oscillate or looking back“, in the sentence (2) means „revert“ or returns to God, in the sentence. In this explanation, the word „turn“ belongs to the polysemy verb type, and form of action verb because it shows the activities or actions carried out by the offender or subject.

Datum 3**Types** : **Polysemy Verb**

Meaning : The word „put“ in the sentence above contains the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context the word „put“ has a double meaning

or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „enter“ or bring into the way, in the sentence (2) means „place or position“ which means put someone or an item, while in the sentence (3) means „create“. In this explanation, the word „put“ belongs to the polysemy verb type and form of an action verb. The verb polysemy of action is a verb type polysemy that indicates the activities or actions carried out by the perpetrators or subjects.

Datum 4

Type : **Polysemy Verb**

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word **say** is the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context of the sentence, the word **say** has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) has the meaning **revealed**, while in the sentence (2) means say or pronounce. The word **say** in that sentence belongs to the polysemy verb type, and form of an action verb. The verb polysemy of action is a verb type polysemy that indicates the activities or actions carried out by the perpetrators or subjects.

Datum 5

Type : **Polysemy Verb**

Meaning : Based on the context of the sentence, the word „lose“ has a double meaning or more than one. In sentence (1) means „stray“ or is in the wrong way, in the sentence (2) means „bereave“ which is meant here

is the loss of hope while in the sentence (3) has the meaning „fail“. And the whole sentence is included in the type of polysemy verb and form of state verb. The word included state verb because it is a verb that shows activities that describe a condition that is suffered by the perpetrator or subject.

Datum 6

Type : Polysemy Verb

Meaning : In the sentence above the word „grant“ contains the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context of the sentence, the word „grant“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „give“ or give something, while in the sentence (2) means „accept“. The word „grant“ in that sentence belongs to the polysemy of verb type and form of process verb. The word „grant“ is a process verb because it is a verb that indicates a process that is being carried out by the actor or subject.

Datum 7

Type : Polysemy Noun

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word „love“ includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „love“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „amour“ or feeling that is in a person, while in the sentence (2) means „affection“. Based on the explanation, it can be concluded that the word „love“ is

included in the polysemy of the noun type and form of a basic noun. A basic noun is a noun that has not changed or has not received any prefixes. Therefore the word „love“ in the form of a basic noun.

Datum 8

Type : Polysemy Noun

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word „pleasure“ is the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „pleasure“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „joy or excitement“, in the sentence (2) means „bounty“ or it can mean a gift of grace given by God, while in the sentence (3) means „enjoyment“. Based on the explanation, it can be concluded that the word „pleasure“ is included in the polysemy of the noun type and form of a basic noun. A basic noun is a noun that has not changed or has not received any prefixes. Therefore the word „pleasure“ in the form of a basic noun.

Datum 9

Type : Polysemy Noun

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word „pain“ is the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „pain“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „sickness“ or inconvenience that is in our body, in the sentence (2) it means „soreness because of love“, while in the sentence (3) means „wound“ or feel pain due to being underestimated about the heart or feeling. Based on the

explanation, it can be concluded that the word „pain“ is included in the polysemy of the noun type and form of a basic noun. A basic noun is a noun that has not changed or has not received any prefixes. Therefore the word „pain“ in the form of a basic noun.

Datum 10

Type : **Polysemy Adjective**

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word "true" includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word "true" has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) it means "right" or as it is, while in the sentence (2) has the meaning „real“ or it can be interpreted to mean that it really exists and is tangible. In this explanation, it can be concluded that the word „true“ is included in the type of polysemy adjective and the form of a basic adjective. Polysemy of basic adjectives is a form consisting of one morpheme. So the word „true“ is a form of a basic adjective that has more than one meaning and no more than one morpheme.

Datum 11

Type : **Polysemy Adjective**

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word „beautiful“ includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „beautiful“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „fancy“ or can also be interpreted as good in the eyes, while in the sentence (2)

has the meaning „pretty“. In this explanation, it can be concluded that the word „beautiful“ is included in the type of polysemy adjective and the form of a basic adjective. Polysemy of basic adjectives is a form consisting of one morpheme. So the word „beautiful“ is a form of a basic adjective that has more than one meaning and no more than one morpheme.

Datum 12

Type : Polysemy Adjective

Meaning : The word „good“ in the sentence above includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „good“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „well“, while in the sentence (2) means „happy“ or means the state or feeling happy and at ease (free of any troublesome). In this explanation, it can be concluded that the word „good“ is included in the type of polysemy adjective and the form of a basic adjective. Polysemy of basic adjectives is a form consisting of one morpheme. So the word „good“ is a form of a basic adjective that has more than one meaning and no more than one morpheme.

Datum 13

Type : Polysemy Adjective

Meaning : The word „whole“ in the sentence above includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „whole“ has a

double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) has the meaning „entire“ or shows a wholeness, while in the sentence (2) means „perfect“ or can be interpreted to be flawless and blemish. In the explanation, it can be concluded that the word „whole“ belongs to the type of polysemy adjective and form of a basic adjective. Polysemy of basic adjectives is a form consisting of one morpheme. The word „whole“ is a form of a basic adjective that has more than one meaning and no more than one morpheme.

Datum 14

Type : **Polysemy Adjective**

Meaning : In the sentence above, the word „lost“ includes the meaning of polysemy. Based on the context, the word „lost“ has a double meaning or more than one meaning. In sentence (1) means „stray or misdirected“, while in the sentence (2) has the meaning „sheer off“ or can be interpreted to disappear and not be seen again. In the explanation, it can be concluded that the word „whole“ belongs to the type of polysemy adjective and form of a basic adjective. Polysemy of basic adjectives is a form consisting of one morpheme. The word „whole“ is a form of a basic adjective that has more than one meaning and no more than one morpheme.

C. Discussion

After collecting data, the researcher needs to discuss the findings in order to clarify the answers of the problems that existed in previous chapter. There are two research questions used in this research. The first research question about types of polysemy and the second about the meaning of polysemy. The data used for this research are song lyrics in Thank You Allah and Forgive Me by Maher Zain.

Based on the finding of this research that has been analyzed, the first question is about types of polysemy. In order to answer the research question, the researcher used theory from Alwi.³¹ In that theory describes four types of polysemy there are polysemy verb, polysemy noun, polysemy adjective, and polysemy adverb. After the researcher analyzing the data, the researcher found fourteen data included in the types of polysemy. The first is polysemy verb, the researcher found twelve words included in polysemy verb there are: *watching, lose, turn, put, say* and *grant*. The second type is polysemy noun, the researcher found six words included in polysemy noun there are: *love, pleasure* and *pain*. The third is polysemy adjective, the researcher found eight words included in polysemy adjective there are: *whole, lost, true, beautiful* and *good*. The last is polysemy adverb. In this type, the researcher has not found the words included in polysemy adverb. It can be concluded that the researcher found thirty data included polysemy verb, polysemy noun, and

polysemy adjective. The most used type of polysemy in song lyrics by Maher Zain is polysemy verb.

Based on the finding above, the researcher tends to discuss this present work with several previous research. The first previous research was carried out by Tahir. The results of this previous research, the researcher found the words polysemy in Adele song. Based on the analysis of the data there are twenty polysemy that found in fifteen songs of Adele and seven words classes, namely: verb: find, close, down, hold, play, end, hurt, like, see, tell, made, save; noun: back, out, down, one, end, hurt; adjective: good, hard; adverb: back, close, out, over; conjunction: over, like; preposition: on; and numeral: one. In this research, the researcher also found the words that has polysemy meaning and categorize them in the type of polysemy and form of polysemy. The data used by researcher is same as previous research used song lyrics.³²

The second previous research carried out by Setianingrum. This previous research found about type of polysemy and the data used was vocabulary in the handbook of islamic banking. Based on the previous research, this research found some of the same research results. In this research also found type of polysemy, and the the researcher categorize in three types there are polysemy verb, polysemy noun, and polysemy

adjective.³³ This research used different data with the previous research. The previous research used vocabulary in the handbook of islamic banking and in this research used song lyrics by Maher Zain.

Relating previous research, this research gave a new finding. The researcher analyzed the type of polysemy used song lyrics from Maher Zain on two albums „Thank You Allah“ and „Forgive Me“. In other to complete this discussion, the researcher looks forward a good contribution in this research that can be given to the society, especially for music listeners.

D. Cheking Data Trustworthiness

The researcher mentioned that this research used asking expert technique to check data trustworthiness. This technique allowed the researcher to seek for the truth and to ensure that the data obtained in the research was convenient to what the researcher intended.

The researcher took the data from the documents in lyrics Maher Zein songs showed the result in order to verify the data. The researcher explained the findings and asked one of the lecturer of TBI that the data were convenient to what came from participants. It made the data could be valid and be away from wrong interpretation.

In the process, the researcher showed the answer sheets the findings in the research by matching the words about the polysemy in lyric Maher Zein

After doing that, the researcher asked one of the lecturer of TBI whether all the polysemy found in each analyzed in the words in lyrics Maher Zein song were order to clarify the findings.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing and discussing the problem in previous chapter, the researcher would like to present some conclusion. Beside, the researcher also gave suggestion.

A. Conclusion

This chapter presents the conclusion of the research based on the analysis and discussion explained in the previous chapter. It includes the types of polysemy used in Maher Zain's songs and the meaning of polysemy in Maher Zain's songs.

1. The types of polysemy in selected song lyrics from Maher Zain are polysemy noun, polysemy verb and polysemy adjective.
2. In this research, the researcher found a word that has more than one meaning in Maher Zain's song, in which there are 11 song taken from two albums, namely the albums Forgive Me and Thank You Allah. the researcher has analyzed the song by marking the word polysemy so that readers can more easily understand the word polysemy found in Maher Zain songs.

B. Suggestion

This research is only limited to discussing the type of polysemy and form of polysemy in Maher Zain's song lyrics on album „Thank You Allah“ and „Forgive Me“ so that suggestions for other researchers who will be

researching about polysemy are to discuss related to the type of lingual unit of polysemy, type the relationship types of the meaning of polysemy, and also the level of syntax that is the function of polysemy. The researcher hope the readers can understand more broadly about semantic and polysemy itself.
